WHAT'S AT STAKE

With both teams sitting with six points in the NASL Spring Standings, the winning club could put itself in striking distance of the New York Cosmos, who are off this weekend, and land in second place.

The Armada FC leads the league in total goals scored (eight) and goals per match average (2.0). With the reward of that attack-heavy mindset also comes some risk, as late goals allowed by breakdowns on the back end proved to be the Armada FC's maker in losses to the Fort Lauderdale Strikers and Tampa Bay Rowdies.

But the soccer gods returned the favor to Jacksonville last Saturday when young Jamaican forward Akeil Barrett, who subbed on for Lucas Rodriguez in the 82nd minute, stole the ball at midfield, juked a defender and fed forward Alhassane Keita with a gliding through-ball that Keita guided into the bottom right corner of the goal in the 93rd minute, proving to be the game-winner. In the match's waning seconds, Armada FC goalkeeper Miguel Gallardo preserved the lead with two heroic saves.

Indy Eleven has proven to be a steady team thus far with one win (San Antonio) and three draws (New York, Carolina and Atlanta). The Eleven, Cosmos and Silverbacks are the only undefeated teams in the NASL. Indy also has a nine-game undefeated streak (4W-5D-0L) dating back to last October.

The Eleven played to a draw last Saturday with the RailHawks in Indianapolis after Carolina's Blake Wagner put home a goal and knotted the score at 1-1.

PLAYERS TO WATCH

Jacksonville: Keita was named NASL Player of the Week after his stellar performance against San Antonio. He was also named to the NASL Team of the Week along with attacking midfielder Marcos Flores, who notched an assist against the Scorpions. Both Keita and Flores are the Armada FC's leaders in points with two goals and an assist each.

Indy Eleven: Forward Charlie Rugg, a former draft pick of Major League Soccer's LA Galaxy, has notched a goal and assist while playing every minute during the team's undefeated streak. Midfielder Victor Pineda's opening goal in a 2-0 triumph over Minnesota United FC solidified his place on the starting 11 this season. Previously a member of the Chicago Fire Academy at the U-16 level in 2008, he became the club's first homegrown product signing in 2010.

NOTABLES

- So far this season, the Armada FC have been unstoppable at home and have done so by getting ahead early. Four of the five goals the team has scored at home have occurred in the first half, including two within the first four minutes.
- Midfielder Jaime Castrillon will miss his second-straight match with an injury to his right foot. He is out approximately two to four weeks recovering from a bone bruise.
- Indy Eleven has not yet won in the state of Florida, posting an 0W-1D-2L record over the 2014 Fall and Spring Seasons. The Eleven has lost twice to the Strikers in Fort Lauderdale once in the fall and one in the spring and drew with the Rowdies in St. Petersburg last spring.

• Three matches into the Spring Season, 17 of the 24 active players on the Armada FC roster have seen action. Players who have not yet seen the pitch are defenders Jordan Gafa, Ramak Safi and Joseph Toby, midfielder Nico Zaldana, backup goalkeepers David Sierra and Sebastian Evers and forward Tyler Williams.

KEITA, FLORES RACK UP NASL ACCOLADES

Forward Alhassane Keita earned NASL Player of the Week honors for the first time in club history on Monday. The 31-year-old Guinea international scored the game-winner in the 93rd minute of the Armada FC's 2-1 win over San Antonio last Saturday in Jacksonville. He was also named to the NASL Team of the Week on Wednesday.

Attacking midfielder Marcos Flores was also named to the Team of the Week after notching an assist on Pascal Millien's fourth minute goal against the Scorpions and using his creativity to control the flow of the Armada FC's attack.

Forward Jemal Johnson was the first Armada FC player to be named to the Team of the Week in Week One after scoring his record-breaking goal just 12 seconds into the match against FC Edmonton on April 4.

VETERANS LEADING THE ATTACK

The Armada FC roster is a solid mix of young and veteran players with an average age of 26, but the scoring has by far and away been dominated by veterans with the average goal scorer age being 30. Goal scorers so far have been Keita (31), Hoyos (31), Johnson (30), Flores (29) and Millien (29).

ARMADA FC SIGNS CANADIAN PRODIGY CHAIM ROSERIE

The Armada FC signed 16-year-old Canadian forward Chaim Roserie (HIME ROSE-er-ee) on Friday, pending ITC clearance approval. The prodigy from Mississauga, Ontario, Canada, spent his youth career playing at the Mississauga Falcons and West Toronto Cobras, considered to be some of Canada's most elite clubs. He also trained at the AC Milan Training Camp in 2008 and 2009. Roserie was also named Most Valuable Player of his school's team, St. Joan of Arc Secondary School, in 2010 and 2011. At 16 years, seven months and 21 days, Roserie is the second-youngest player to sign with an NASL club in the modern era. FC Edmonton midfielder Hanson Boakai holds the record at 16 years, three months and 23 days, signing with the Eddies on Feb. 20, 2013. Roserie, who was invited to try out and has been training with the team since last August will not be eligible to play in official matches for the Armada FC until clearance is received from FIFA due to the fact that Roserie is a minor. He will, however, continue to train with the team and is able to compete in friendlies.

BRIEF CLUB HISTORY

Jacksonville was awarded an NASL club on July 25, 2013, after a league meeting in Dallas. Owner Mark Frisch and general manager Dario Sala formed the Sunshine Soccer Group to bring professional soccer in Jacksonville. On Feb. 18, 2014, the club was officially branded the Jacksonville Armada FC. On June 11, 2014, the club announced Argentinian José Luis Villarreal as head coach and later announced on Jan. 26, 2015, that he would be joined at the helm with long-time friend and Lionel Messi mentor Guillermo Hoyos as co-head coach. On Oct. 21, 2014, Orlando City SC goalkeeper Miguel Gallardo was signed as the first player in club history.




