Dear Mr. Commisso:

I am responding to you on behalf of Mr. Cordeiro. As I believe he stated in his previous letter, he is traveling out of the country in support of the World Cup Bid. This week, he is between Jakarta, Copenhagen and Dubai! This pace of travel is likely to continue up to the vote on June 13.

Nonetheless, his offer to re-open a dialogue in his April 19 letter was made in the spirit of finding a path forward, and so, as previously noted, he has delegated this matter to me and Board representative(s) to meet with you. Mr. Cordeiro asked me to reiterate in particular that he has full confidence in my role as CEO of the Federation.

In your letters to us, you refer to a proposal on which we have no information. Before we meet in person, it would be helpful to have an outline of this proposal to make the meeting more productive. If you are concerned with maintaining confidentiality of your proposal, as suggested in your letter, we are willing to discuss your concerns and would invite you to propose a solution, such as, for example, the path you suggested in the footnote of your April 13 letter.

Finally, while we are prepared to have this conversation in the spirit of reopening the dialogue, we are prepared to do so without pressures of artificial deadlines or suggestions of going to the media.
