

Ottawa Fury FC Announces Open Tryout Dates

Friday, August 8, 2013 (Ottawa, ON) – Ottawa Fury FC today announced that they will host an open tryout November 20-21 at the Ben Franklin Superdome in Ottawa. The tryout will provide an opportunity for local, non-local and foreign players to prove their skills and potentially earn the opportunity to join Fury FC for their inaugural North American Soccer League (NASL) season in 2014.

"There has been a surge of interest since the appointment of Marc Dos Santos as the club's first head coach," said Fury FC President John Pugh. "Now we hope to see a surge of talent on the field as we prepare for our historic first game."

"We are very excited about our first open tryout," said Fury FC Head Coach Marc Dos Santos. "We can recruit players from all over the world, but I think it's important that we start the process right here in our backyard. I believe we'll see some great talent at this first tryout camp."

Players will be asked to complete an online registration form at OttawaFuryFC.com that will remain open until October 31. Those accepted into the open tryouts will be contacted by the club on or before November 1. Acceptance is subject to a select number of player at each position which are limited. A registration fee of \$50 will be charged to all players accepted into the open tryout will also be responsible for their own transportation, accommodation and meals during their time in Ottawa.

The November tryout will be open to the media. Further media details will be made available closer to the tryout.
