

Fury FC Offer Entertaining Soccer at an Affordable Price

Monday, October 28, 2013 (Ottawa, ON) – Professional soccer arrives in Ottawa in the Spring of 2014 and Ottawa sports fans can enjoy North American Soccer League action for as little as \$13.44 per game (plus HST and CRF).

Keeping with the theme set earlier this week with the announcement of season seat prices for the Ottawa REDBLACKS, the Ottawa Sports and Entertainment Group (OSEG) announced today a series of accessible and affordable season seat prices for Ottawa Fury FC home games.

Season seats for 16 Fury FC home games start at \$215.04 (plus HST and Capital Replacement Fund). Seats nearest the centre line go for \$374.34 per seat (plus HST and CRF).

Fans aged 16 and under receive a discount. A season seat for youth supporters costs as little as \$10.45 per game (plus HST and CRF).

Special reserved sections for official Fury FC "supporters" groups go for \$11.95 per game (plus HST and CRF; \$191.15 per season, plus HST and CRF).

"We are now just months away from bringing professional soccer to the Nation's Capital," said Fury FC President and OSEG Partner John Pugh. "What a tremendous moment in time this is for our soccer community."

"We believe that the combination of this affordable pricing and top-class North American Soccer League action at a soccer-friendly stadium will draw fans old and new to experience the World's game."

Fury FC will play its first five home games of the 2014 NASL Spring Season at Keith Harris Stadium at Carleton University. The NASL Spring Season runs from April 5 to June 7.

Following a break during the 2014 FIFA World Cup in Brazil, the NASL Fall Season will begin in mid-July when Fury FC moves into its state-of-the-art stadium at Lansdowne Park. The 2014 NASL Fall season goes from July 19 through November 1.





Every seat in the stadium at the refurbished Lansdowne is brand new, complete with arm rests, drink holder and seat backs.
